# Sustainable Procurement Policy

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## 1. Purpose

To ensure that procurement at MAJU supports environmental sustainability, ethical practices, and efficient use of resources.

## 2. Objectives

- Reduce environmental impact through eco-friendly purchasing
- Promote responsible and ethical suppliers
- Improve resource efficiency
- Support sustainable campus operations

## 3. Scope

This policy applies to all departments, faculty, staff, and procurement-related activities at MAJU.

## 4. Sustainable Procurement Principles

### 4.1 Environmental Responsibility

Preference will be given to energy-efficient, recyclable, and environmentally friendly products. The university will reduce single-use plastics and encourage sustainable materials.

### 4.2 Ethical Responsibility

Suppliers must follow fair labor practices and ethical standards. MAJU will avoid partnerships with organizations involved in harmful or unethical activities.

### 4.3 Value for Money

Procurement decisions will consider lifecycle cost, durability, and long-term value rather than only initial price.

## 5. Supplier Requirements

Suppliers are expected to comply with environmental laws, minimize waste, and provide sustainable product options while maintaining ethical practices.



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## 6. Implementation

All departments will consider sustainability criteria during procurement. Staff will be guided to choose environmentally responsible options where feasible.

## 7. Monitoring & Evaluation

Procurement practices will be reviewed regularly. Improvements will be made to enhance sustainability performance.

## 8. Responsibility

This policy will be implemented by the Procurement Department in coordination with the Directorate of Sustainability and Environment (DSE).

## 9. Review

This policy will be reviewed periodically to ensure continuous improvement and alignment with sustainability goals.
